

  - Public at risk







# Impact on WAIT TIME for LAW ENFORCEMENT







#### Then (prior to Sept 2005)

- Wait times for Medical Clearance/ Screening at UHS ER - 9 hours, 18 min.
- Wait times for Medical Clearance/ Screening <u>and</u> Psychiatric Evaluation was between 12 and 14 hours.

#### **Now**

- The wait time for Medical Clearance/ Screening at the Crisis Care Center is 10 minutes.
- Wait time for Medical Clearance/Screening and Psychiatric Evaluation is 20 minutes.

### **Revocation Rates 2010**

Federal Revocation Rate: 66%

Two-thirds of returning prisoners are re-arrested for new crimes within 3 years or their release. Second Chance Act, 110TH CONGRESS REPORT to US HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES


#### State Revocation Rate:


